

RULES OF PLAY

Administrator of the Raffle: All draws will be administered and supervised by Canada Donates Inc. (the “Charitable Organization”). Any dispute will be decided by the Charitable Organization.

Draw Date: The Charitable Organization will run weekly draws. The draw dates will be every Wednesday, starting on July 6, 2016. The value of the prize will be determined by the ticket sales for the period between the draw date and the prior draw date (the “Selling Period”).

Purchasing Tickets: Tickets can be purchased at the 50/50Tics kiosks, on the 50/50Tics website, on the Canada Donates website and on the websites of Canada Donates charitable partners.

Ticket Prices: Ticket prices for the draws shall be as follows:

- One (1) number for \$2.00;
- Three (3) numbers for \$5.00;
- Ten (10) numbers for \$10.00;
- Thirty (30) numbers for \$20.00;
- One Hundred (100) numbers for \$50.00;
- Two (2) numbers each week for 52 draws for \$2.00 per week, (\$520.00 total);
- Five (5) numbers each week for 52 draws for \$5.00 per week, (\$520.00 total);
- Fifteen (15) numbers each week for 52 draws for \$10.00 per week (\$520.00 total);
- Fifty (50) numbers each week for the year for \$20.00 per week (\$1,040.00 total);

Use of Proceeds: The winner shall be paid a cash prize equivalent to 50% of the ticket sales for the Selling Period. The Charitable Organization will distribute the remaining 50% of the ticket sales to its charitable partners (less fees and costs).

Random Winner Selection: On the draw date a representative of the Charitable Organization will randomly select the winning number from a printed lot of all the numbers sold during the Selling Period.

Notification of Winning Number: The winning number will be posted on the Charitable Organization’s website and on the 50/50Tics website. The Charitable Organization and 50/50Tics will also use social media (Facebook, Twitter, etc.) to advertise the winning number.

Claiming a Prize: A prize may be claimed after the authenticity of the ticket is verified. In order to verify the winning ticket, a meeting must be set up with the Charitable Organization or 50/50Tics by using the contact information below.

Odds of Winning: The odds of winning a draw depend on the number of tickets purchased during the Selling Period.

Lost Tickets: The winner is required to present his/her ticket to collect his/her prize so it is important to maintain possession of tickets.

Unclaimed Winning Tickets: The period for claiming a prize is two weeks from the draw date. If the prize is not claimed within two weeks, the Charitable Organization will apply the proceeds to another draw administered by the Charitable Organization.

General: By participating in the draws, each participant:

- (i) is bound by these Rules of Play;
- (ii) consents to the use of the winner's name, address (city and province only), voice and/or photograph for advertising and promotional purposes without further compensations or notifications;
- (iii) consents to receive email correspondence from 50/50Tics and the Charitable Organization;
- (iv) consents that, if paying for a 50/50 ticket by credit card, they are 19 years of age or older;
- (v) represents and warrants they will not copy or otherwise reproduce or duplicate any ticket in an attempt to alter the draw in any way; and,
- (vi) will indemnify, defend, hold harmless, release, and waive any and all claims against the charitable organization and 50/50Tics and each of the respective parents, affiliated companies, subsidiaries, officers, directors, members, managers, employees, agents, licensees, distributors, dealers, retailers, printers, representatives and advertising and promotion agencies, and any and all other companies associated with the raffle, and all of their respective officers, directors, members, managers, employees, agents and representatives for any injury, damage or loss that may occur, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from the participation in the raffle or from the receipt or use of any prize or any travel or activity related to the claiming, receipt or use of any prize.

Applicable Laws: The laws of the province of New Brunswick shall be the applicable laws.
